Dear Families,

Nevada Sage Waldorf School is proactively responding to the coronavirus outbreak to ensure we are prepared. The Faculty and Staff are working to prevent the spread of illness on our campus and developing a response plan should a school closure occur. Here are some of the steps we are taking.

- We are reviewing and upgrading our daily cleaning protocols.
- Our faculty is discussing ideas for continued learning options during a possible two week closure.
- We are developing a communications plan to keep families informed.

We all need to do our part to stay healthy. The most effective way to minimize the spread of infectious disease is to follow basic health best practices including:

- Staying home when feeling sick. We encourage students and staff to stay home when sick. Those who have a fever at school should go home and stay home until at least 24 hours after they no longer have a fever without the use of fever-reducing medicine.
- Informing the office when your child is sick so we can collect accurate data.
- Maintaining basic hygiene such as washing hands thoroughly and covering up coughs/sneezes.
- Avoid touching your face, particularly your eyes, nose, and mouth.

Also, please remain sensitive to how you discuss the coronavirus with your child. Remember to keep the information age appropriate and be aware of the news stories that are playing when your child is also listening/watching.

The health and safety of our school community is paramount. We are monitoring new developments with the coronavirus and will continue to be vigilant in assessing any risks in our community and keep you informed.
