SCHOOL CLOSURE

When will the school campus open?

On April 1st Governor Sisolak declared that schools are to remain closed until April 30th. This has changed from the previous date of April 16th. We will follow the State directed path of school campus closure until April 30th. Meanwhile distance learning began on March 30 and will continue until the school campus re-opens on April 30th. We are monitoring and reassessing our options daily.

TUITION

Will I be asked to pay tuition during distance learning?

Yes. Your continued support through your tuition payments allows us to continue to support the very lifeblood of the school - our faculty and staff - who despite the building closure have

not stopped working to provide an exceptional educational experience for your children. As many of you know, we are a private non-profit organization that depends on your tuition dollars, 92% of which go directly to support our employees. Of course, we also recognize that there are many families who have been impacted by the sudden economic impact of this pandemic, and we would like to work with those families to maintain a strong connection to the school community.

Can my tuition be adjusted due to financial hardship?

If your family is experiencing a financial hardship, we want to work with you to adjust tuition on a need-basis. Contact the Administrator to discuss a new tuition agreement.

What if I am considering withdrawing my child?

Taking care of our community is our first priority. We want to support and retain our families during this unprecedented time. If you are considering withdrawing due to financial hardship, contact the Administrator.

What if I decide to withdraw now, will the 30 day written notice policy still apply?

As a last measure, if you do need to withdraw due to financial hardship, you can submit a

30-day written notice of withdrawal to the Administrator with a request to have the 30-day written notice policy waived.

Will I be charged for Continuing Care and Early Care?

No. You will not be charged for Continuing Care and Early Care during the school closure. Please see additional information below.

INVOICING

Can I delay my tuition payment due to financial hardship?

Yes. You can request a change in your tuition payment schedule.

Will I be charged for Continuing Care or Early Care during the school closure?

We will not charge for Continuing Care and early care for weeks the building is closed due to coronavirus, commencing March 25 (following our 7-day Spring Break, which was shifted to March 16-24). Your currently-pending April invoice will be adjusted to remove these charges — a reduction that corresponds to the length of the closure currently in place. If the closure is extended, your May invoice will be similarly adjusted, and you may also be entitled to a credit for any prepaid continuing care fees. All final billing adjustments (credits, donations, etc.) will appear on your May invoice, as by then we should know the actual length of the closure.

Alternatively, we would ask those who are financially able to consider the generous act of donating your Continuing Care and Early Care funds to assist us during this difficult time.

Continuing care income is an integral part of our budget, and maintaining your usual payments would help us greatly to support and retain our staff. Instead of removing these items from your invoices, we will gladly revise them to reflect a tax-deductible donation in the same amount. Please notify us if you elect to make this donation. RE-ENROLLMENT 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR

When is the new re-enrollment deadline?

To help us plan for next school year, we are requesting that all families return re-enrollment documents by Friday, March 27. Re-enrollment paperwork will be accepted after that date, but it would help us with 2020-21 budgeting to have the majority of re-enrollment packets returned as soon as possible.

Has the re-enrollment registration fee structure changed?

Yes. The new registration fee structure is a flat fee of \$100 through August 26.

What are my payment options for the registration fee?

You can include the registration fee with your re-enrollment documents. If you cannot pay the registration fee now, we can include it with your supply fee invoice in July.

Is there a penalty if I enroll my child for next school year and need to withdraw?

We would like our families to re-enroll but understand that with the developing COVID-19 pandemic and associated financial crisis, in the coming months, you may need to reevaluate your plans for next school year. If you cannot start the school year with us in August, we ask that you submit a notification by July 24. In addition, until further notice, the 30 day written notice of withdrawal will be inactive, but we would appreciate as much advance notice as possible should you need to withdraw.

How do I submit my re-enrollment and summer program enrollment documents?

Your reenrollment and summer program documents can either be mailed to the school or scanned and emailed to Lori Robertson at enrollment@nevadasagewaldorf.org.

SUMMER PROGRAM

Will NSWS have a Summer Program?

We are planning to hold our Early Childhood Summer Program should it be safe to do so. Return your Summer Program enrollment documents with your re-enrollment documents.

Is there a Summer Program registration fee?

We have decided to waive the summer registration fee for this summer.

What if I need to withdraw from the Summer Program?

You can withdraw from the program through May 29 without a penalty. During the Summer Program if you need to withdraw, you will need to submit a 30 day written notice of withdrawal.

When are payments due for the Summer Program?

Payments for the Summer Program are due June 1 and July 1. If you need to make special invoicing arrangements, please let us know.
